

Sexual Violence Intervention and Prevention Training (SVPT)

Winter Quarter / Spring Semester 2018

UC Davis requires that all incoming graduate and professional students complete Sexual Violence Intervention and Prevention Training (SVPT) within the first six weeks of their beginning classes at UC Davis. Students who are new to UC Davis in Winter Quarter/Spring Semester 2018 or who did not complete the VIP requirement in Fall 2017 can complete the requirement by watching a recording of the 90-minute SVPT presentation and answering the questions below.

Graduate and professional students who are new to UC Davis in Winter Quarter/Spring Semester 2018 are expected to complete the SVPT requirement by Thursday, February 1, 2018. A registration hold will be placed on the accounts of students who do not meet this deadline. The registration hold will prevent them from registering for Spring Quarter/Fall Semester 2018 classes.

To complete the SVPT requirement:

- 2) Answer the questions below based on the information in the SVPT presentation.
- 3) Send a message with your name, UCD student ID number, and your answers to the three questions to svpt@ucdavis.edu.
- 4) You will receive a confirmation email once your correct answers are received and your completion of the SVPT requirement is recorded. If there is currently a registration hold on your account please note that it can take up to 2 business days after you submit your correct answers for the hold to be removed.
